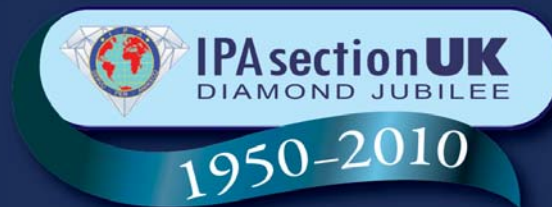




# IPA Thames Valley South Welcomes you to Royal Windsor
