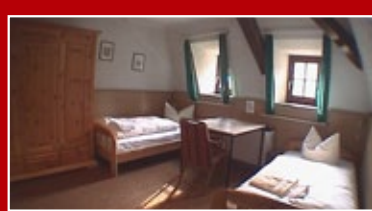

Welcome to the Information and Education Centre, IBZ Schloss Gimborn ...

... the IBZ is surrounded by nature and history in the German region called "Bergisches Land!" (mountainous country)

The Information and Education Centre, Gimborn Castle (IBZ) is an international meeting and further education facility, which is open to all people from all countries.

The IBZ not only organizes seminars. It is also an open house for meetings and events of companies, associations, clubs, IPA conferences, working groups and training institutions. It is also a meeting place for groups of friends, colleagues, IPA members, families, motorcyclists and hikers.

The IBZ facilities located in a lovely area ...

... let you concentrate on the essentials and achieve a distance from the everyday life.

IBZ offers you the space you need. There are four conference rooms in the IBZ:

- the large castle conference room with large balcony. (for 20 to 40 people)
- the special conference room (for 12 to 20 people)
- the French room (for 15 to 25 people)
- the Artur-Winkelmann seminar room (30 to 50 people)

All meeting rooms are located in the castle, or castle annex. They offer modern technology in an historic atmosphere as well as a magnificent view of the palace garden, the castle pond and the woods.

- 38 individually decorated guest rooms (single bed or double bed) are located in different historic buildings: in the castle, in an old school and the old steward's house.

We offer telephone in the guest-rooms, wireless LAN in most rooms and modern presentation technology in conference rooms. All meals are served in the "Schlossrestaurant", across the road.

In the IBZ we offer you:

- 2 TV areas
- a cozy "Tower bar"
- a cozy wine tavern.

Enjoy a great wine selection, fresh beer, spirits and soft drinks at reasonable prices.



Moving and learning

You can use the garden and surroundings of the castle for sports such as volleyball, football, hiking, bowling, meditation, mountain biking (bikes and helmets are available for rent), yoga, jogging and darts. Nearby there are swimming pools and a sauna area.

The region "Bergisches Land" offers many sports and leisure opportunities. Near the IBZ there are beautiful bike trails, hiking trails and many lakes for water sports and swimming. There are natural monuments, historic buildings and historical industrial edifices and museums for you to visit.

IBZ seminars cover ...

... the main current social and political issues, but also topics like communication, health management and professional development.

We always provide professional simultaneous interpretation and use advanced translation technology in order to guarantee smooth communication.
